JOIN THE MONTANA 4-H LEADERSHIP ACADEMY WORKSHOP ON SUNDAY AFTERNOONS IN 2023-2024 4-H YEAR.

THE LEADERSHIP ACADEMY IS A NETWORK OF MONTANA 4-H MEMBERS INTERESTED IN EXPLORING AND DEVELOPING THEIR OWN LEADERSHIP SKILLS WHILE SERVING THEIR COUNTY 4-H PROGRAM IN NEW WAYS.

LOCAL COUNTY LEADERSHIP GROUPS WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO JOIN WITH GROUPS FROM AROUND THE STATE AS WELL AS THE MONTANA 4-H AMBASSADOR OFFICER TEAM, VIRTUALLY AND IN PERSON WHEN POSSIBLE, TO WORK ON SKILL BUILDING, PLANNING, AND MENTORSHIP.

EACH MONTH THE OFFICER TEAM MEMBERS WILL PRESENT A DIFFERENT WORKSHOP TOPIC THAT THEY HAVE FOUND TO BE IMPORTANT AS THEY HAVE GROWN THEIR OWN LEADERSHIP ABILITIES.
