

LEGARD CITIZENSHIP AWARD



The Legard Citizenship Award was developed in memory of Kathy Legard and her grandson, Jake Legard both of whom were active in 4-H. This award recognizes two club members each year who contribute to the 4-H program, come early to help set up, leave late because they are helping to clean up, pitch in wherever needed, and in general go above and beyond the expectations of a 4-H member. The recipients need not be highly accomplished in their project work and they do not have to win all of the awards at the fair, but they should stand out for other reasons.

- Two awards are awarded per club.
- Each club Organizational Leader may nominate one junior and one senior member from their club for this award. (encourage one junior and one senior but you can default to two if not possible)
- Nominated members from each club will be recognized.
- Members may only receive the award once as a junior and once as a senior.
